Varsity Division

Pool & Brackets

The varsity division will consist of 4 pools of up to 5 teams in each pool. Each 5 team pool match will consist of 2 sets to 25 starting at 4-4, must win by 2, no cap. Each 4 team pool will play 3 sets, each set to 25 starting at 4-4, no cap. At the end of pool play, the teams will be divided into four brackets (gold, silver, bronze & flight) with teams ranked 1-5 going to the Gold bracket, teams 6-10 going to the Silver bracket, teams 11-15 going to the Bronze bracket and teams 16-20 going to the Flight division. All bracket games will be best of 3, first 2 sets to 25 starting at 4-4, no cap, and 3rd game to 15 starting at 0-0, no cap. Tournament play will be double elimination. Seeding in pool play is based off the previous year's finish ranking. New teams will be seeded last. Seeding for bracket play will be based on win-loss record in pool play.

If 2 teams are tied, the tie breaking system will be as follows:

1. Head to head record
2. Point spread in head to head games
3. Overall point spread
4. Coin toss

If 3 or more teams are tied, the tie breaking system will be as follows:

1. Head to head record among the tied teams
2. Point spread in head to head games among tied teams
3. Overall point spread
4. Coin toss.

There will be no playoff games to determine seeding.
